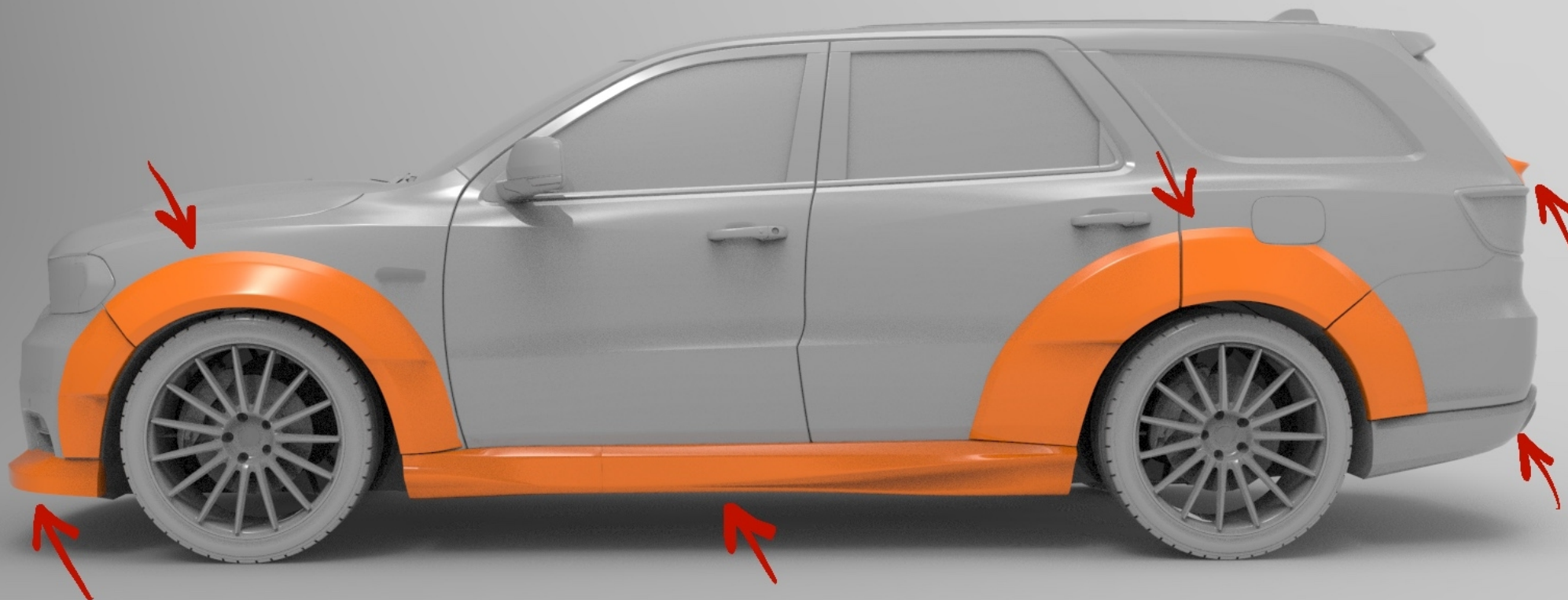

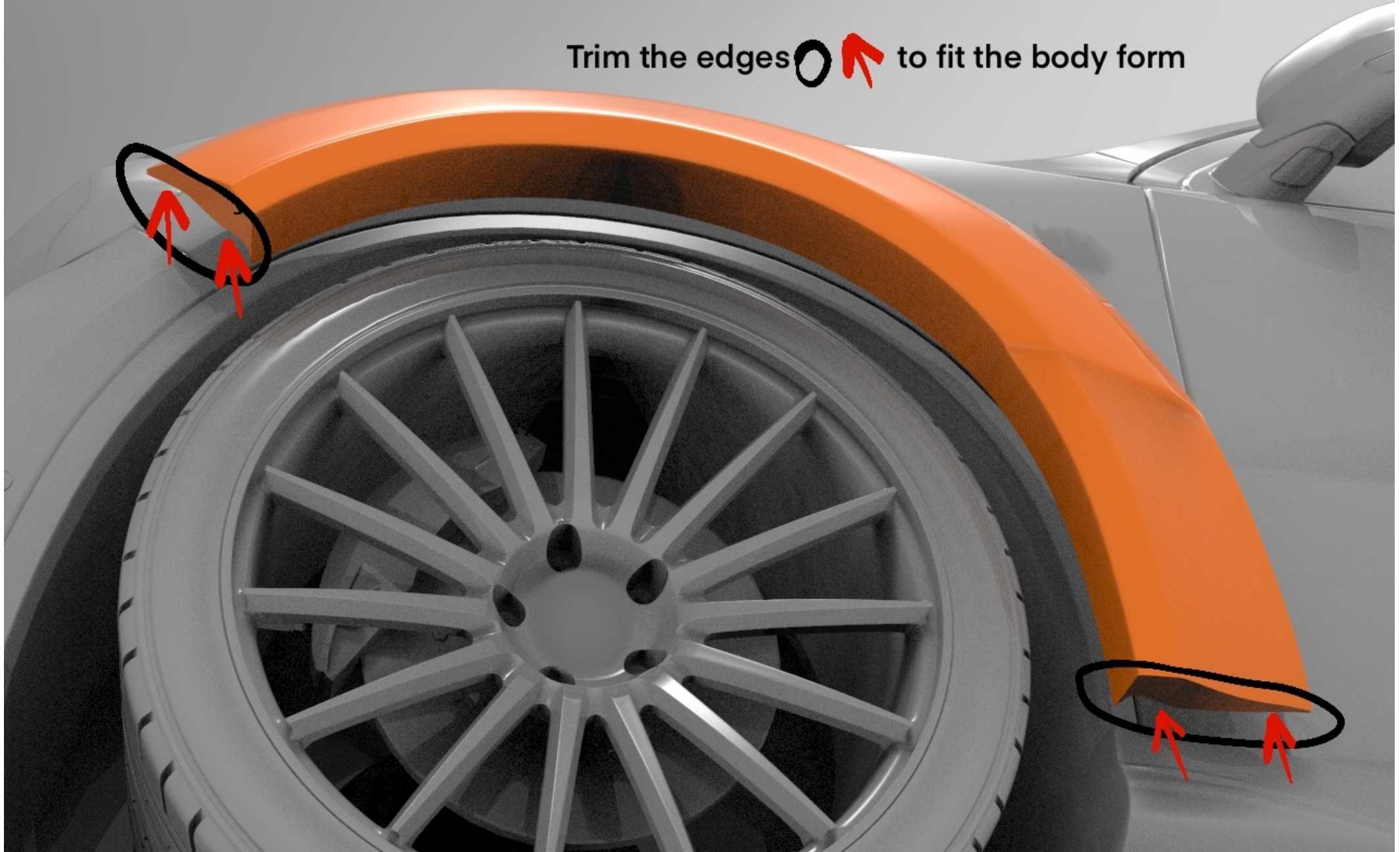
1. First find the right place for each part via the images
2. Find our notes on parts telling you what to do
3. Parts won't fit from the box, you or your bodyshop have to follow this manual to make all parts fit correctly

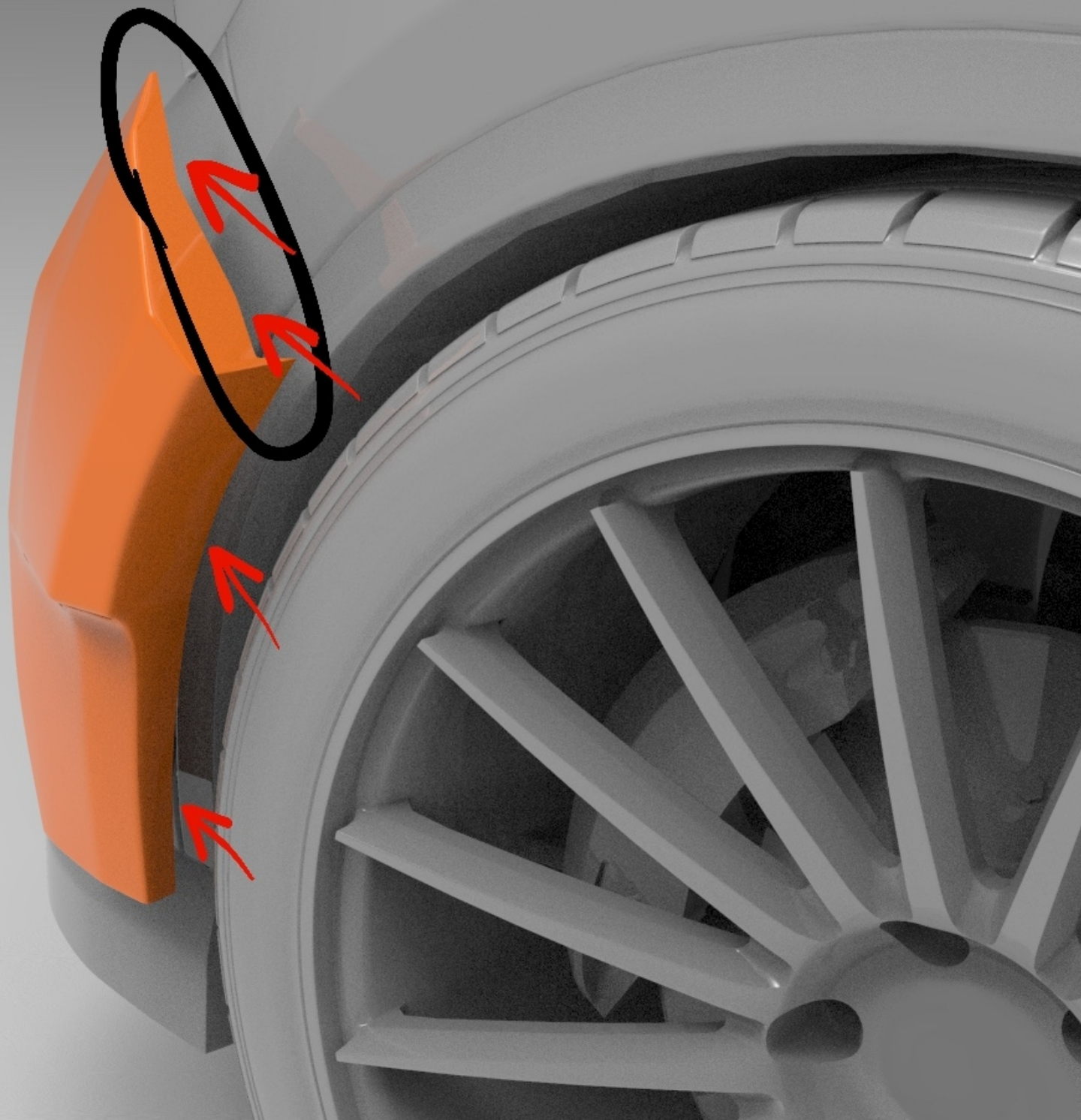


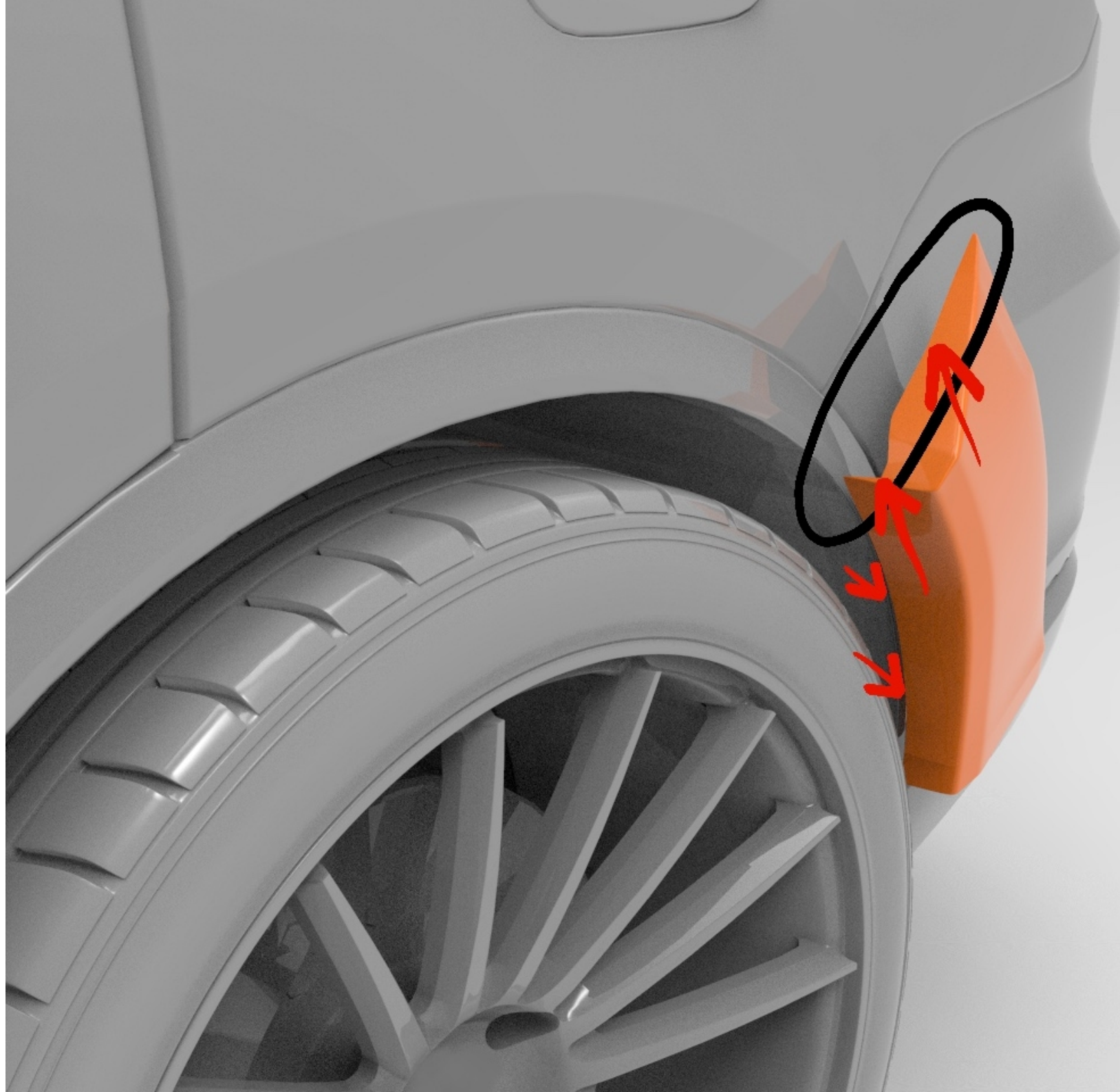
We are leaving some extra material on the edges in order for the installer to trim the edges to fit all body lines



Trim the edges  to fit the body form



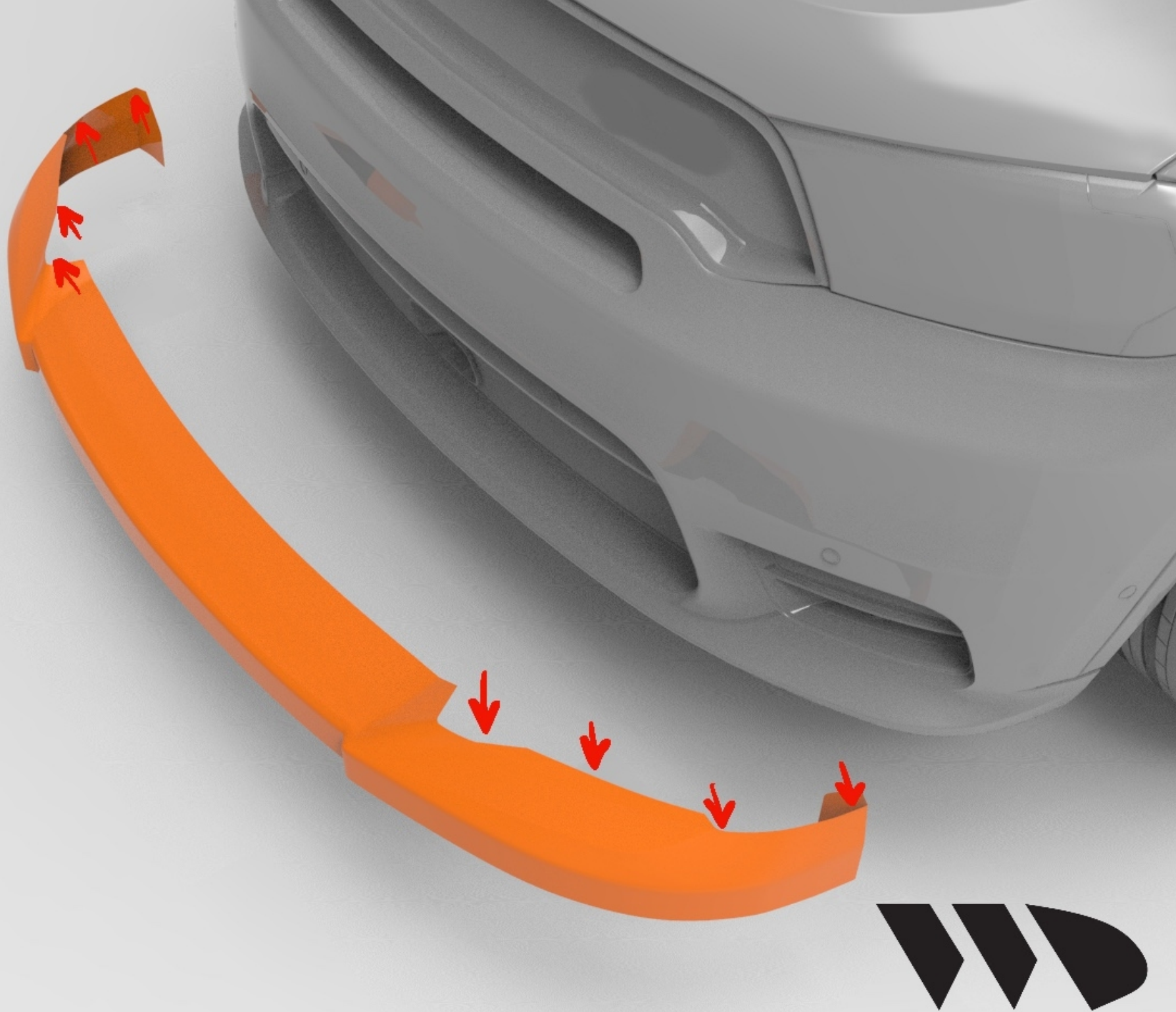


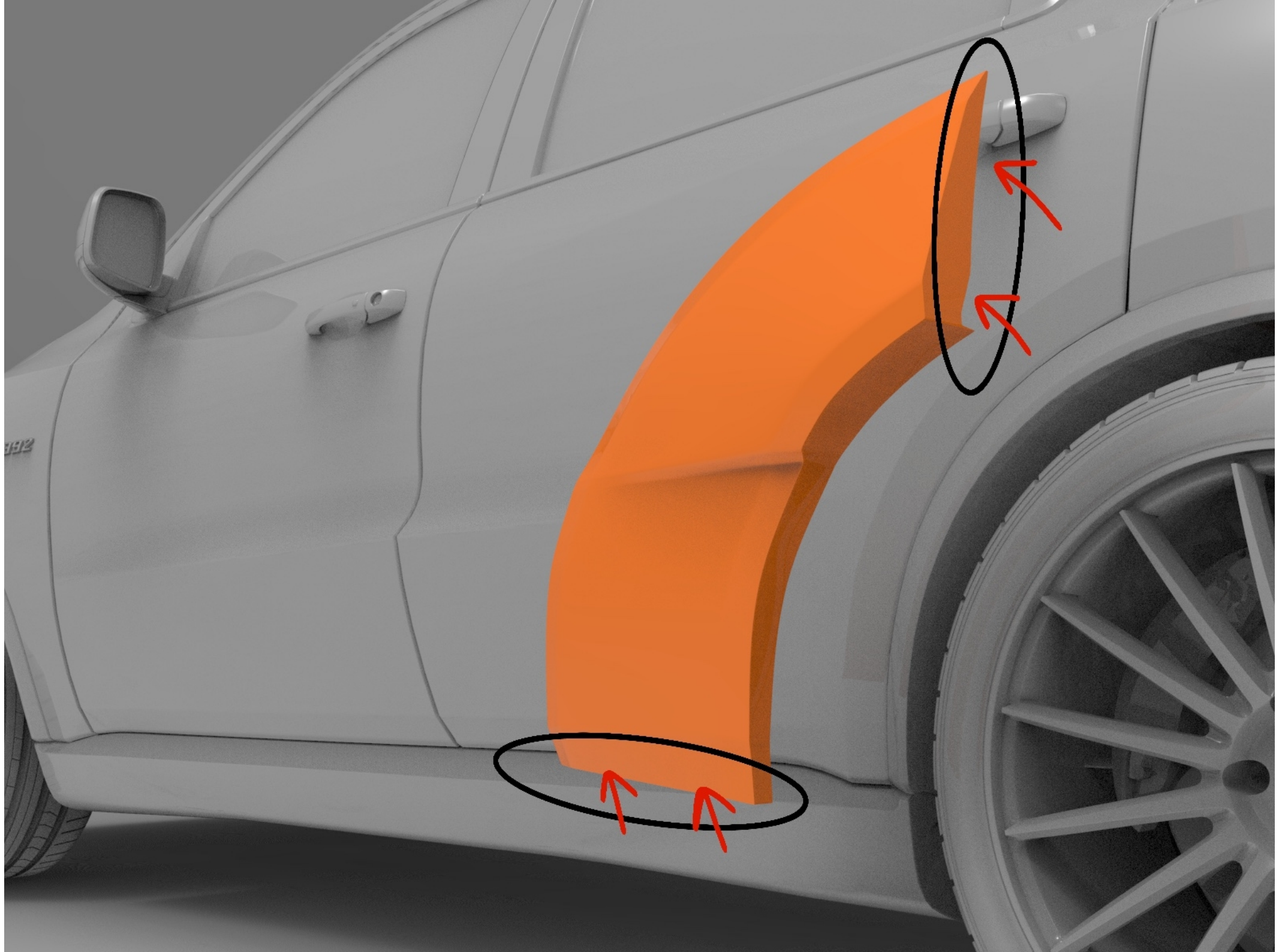


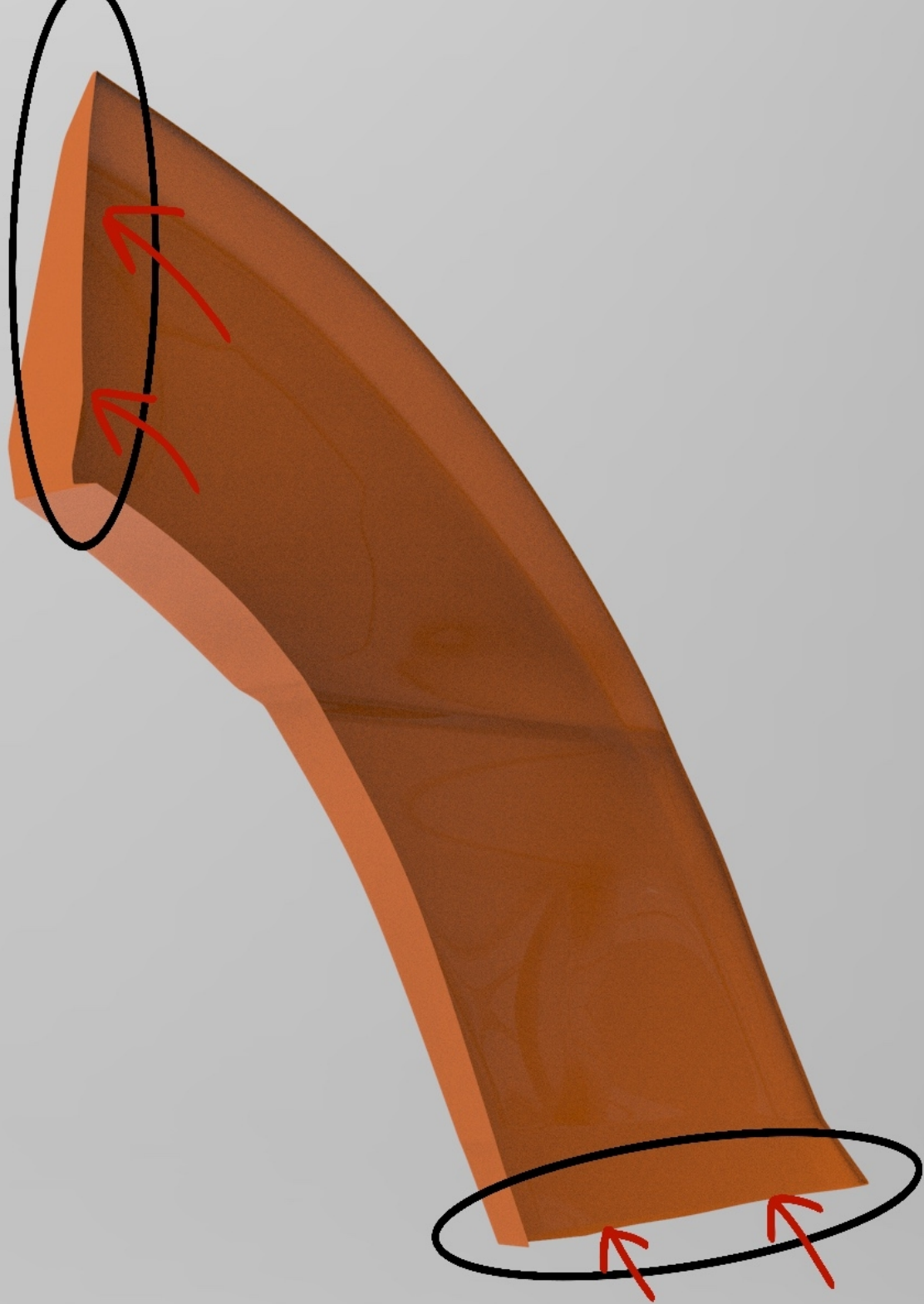


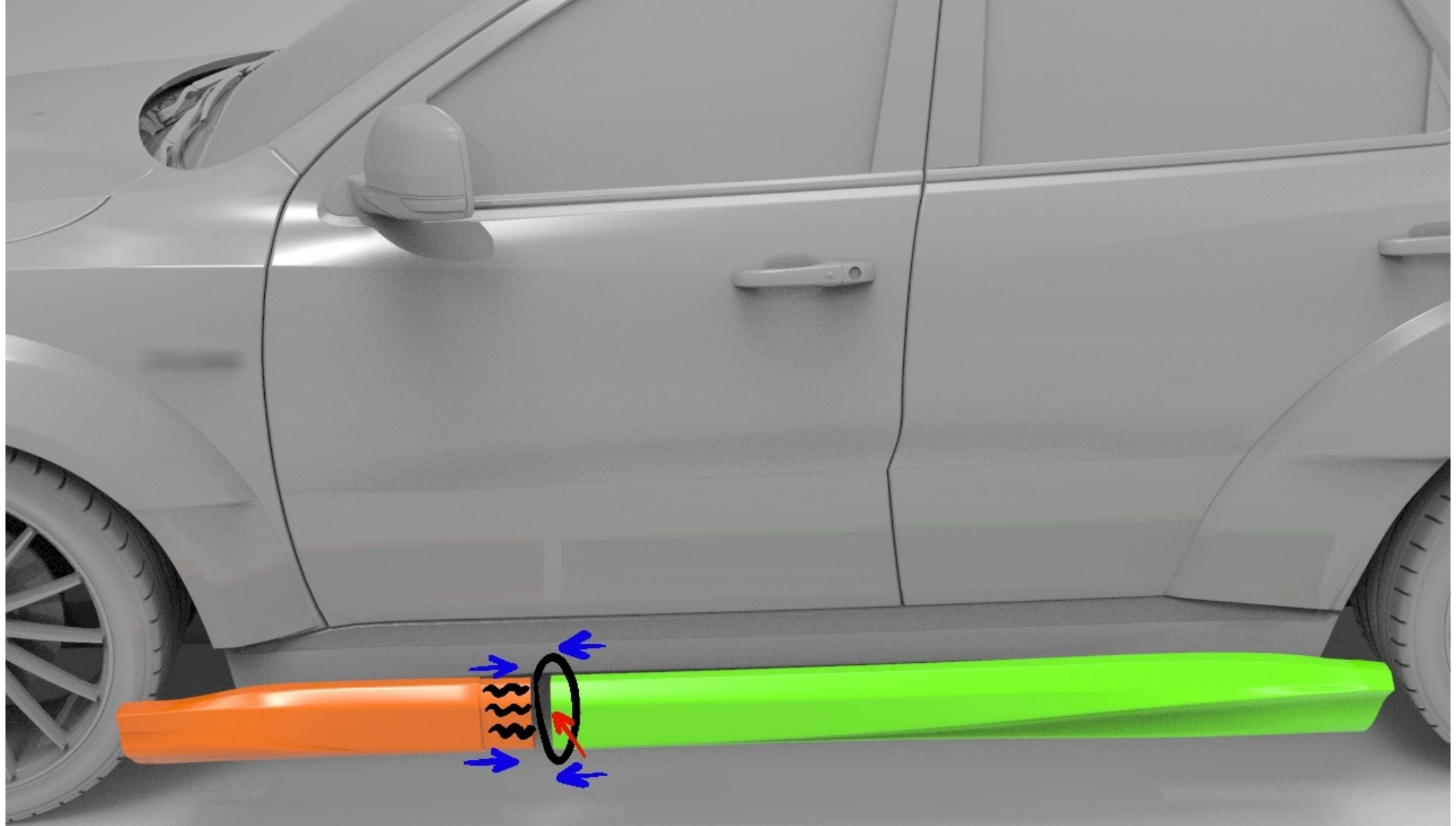




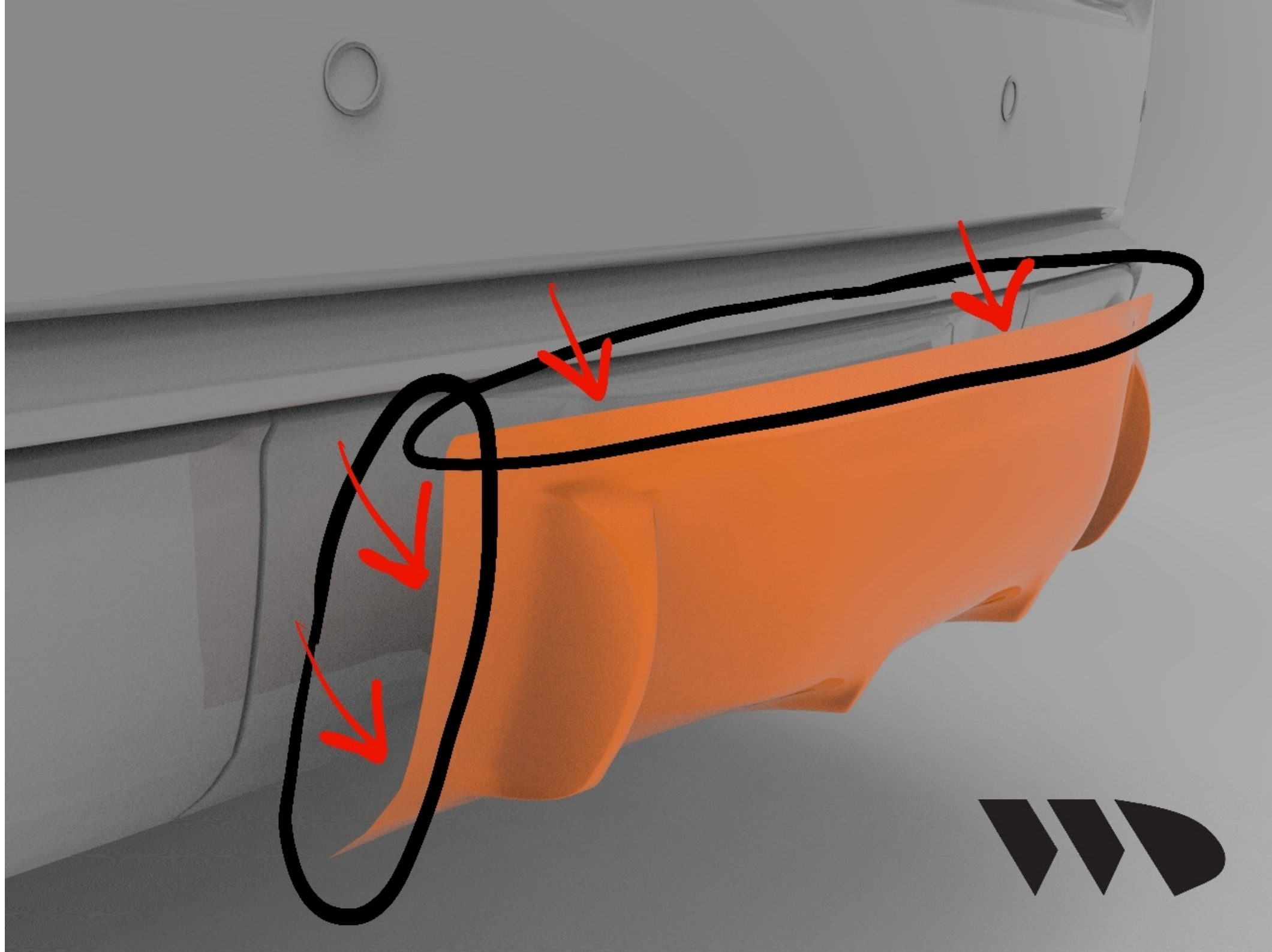


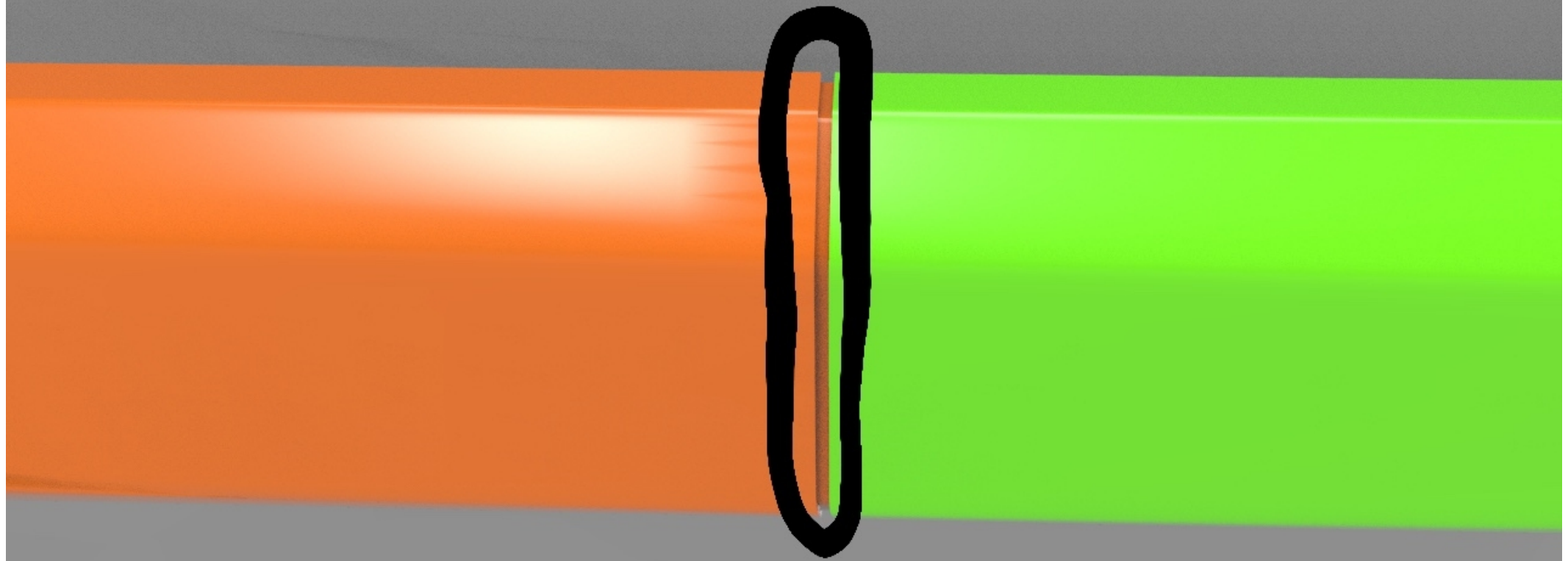






Since we are limited on the size of the box we can ship, we have made side skirts from two pieces, you have to trim them via notes that you will find on the parts and glue 🖐️ them in one piece

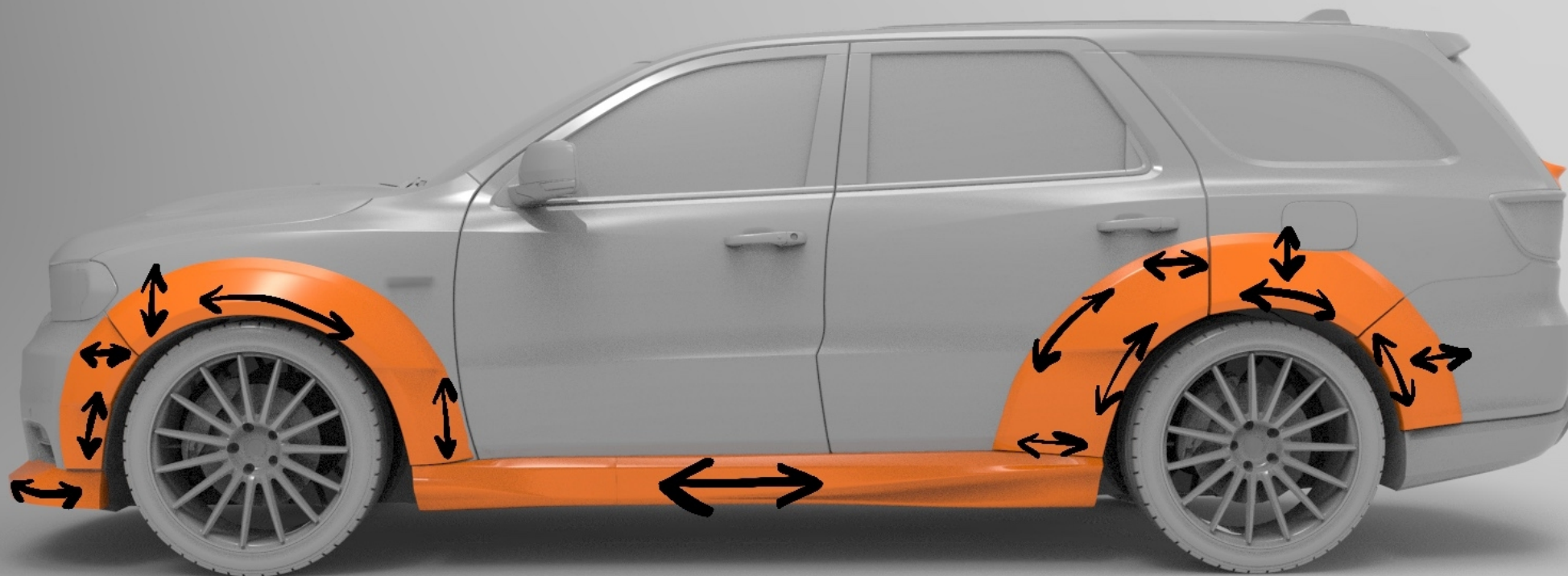




After connecting the side skirt in
one piece we recommend to fill
the gap with bondo and sand it
to a flat surface

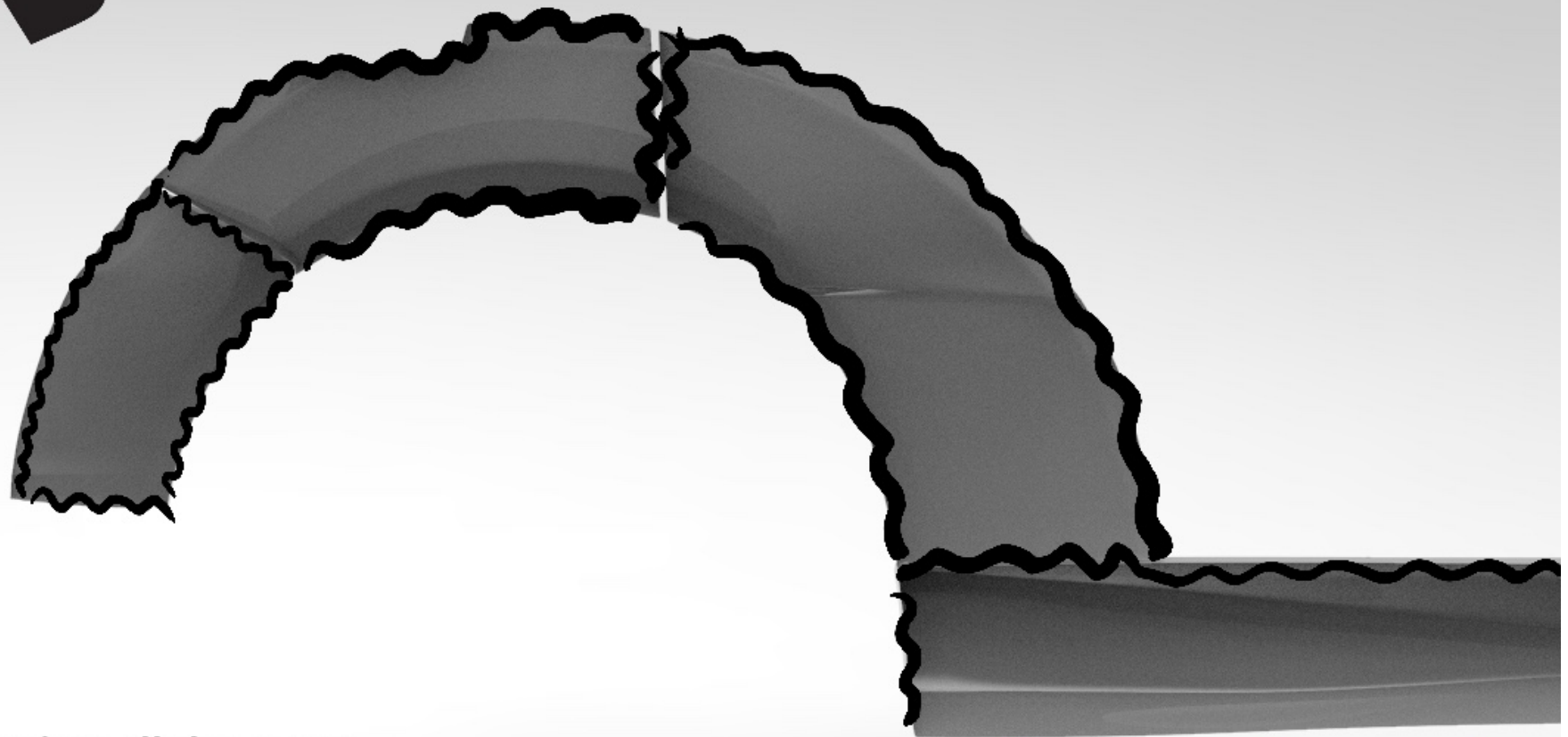


Note: if you have issues with the fitment or gaps between the parts, try turning and moving the parts





Once you are done with trimming and fittings of all 15 parts, you have to sand the edges you trimmed with 400-600 grid, shoot the primer and get them painted!



Once done painting all the parts,
you have to sand (240 grid) and
degrease the backside of all the
parts at the place where you will
be applying the adhesive ~ (3M
550) via pictures



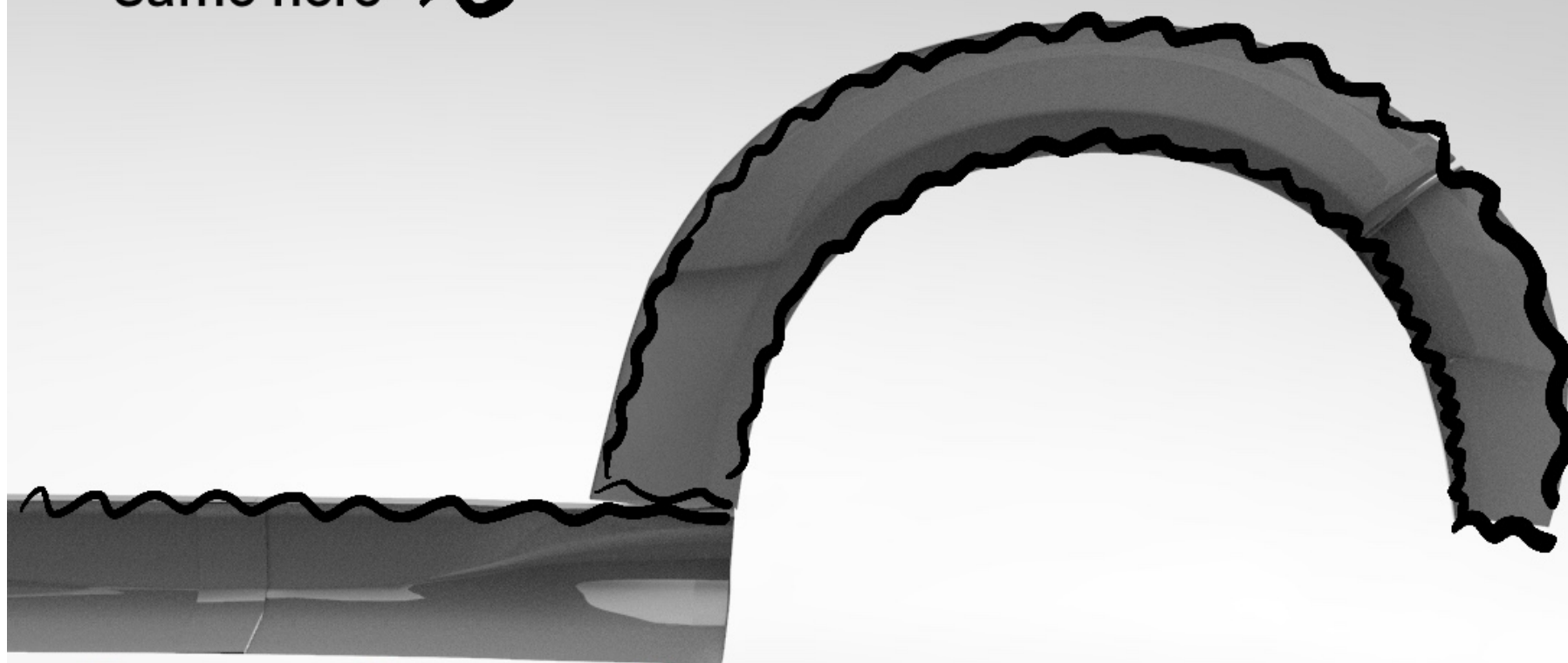

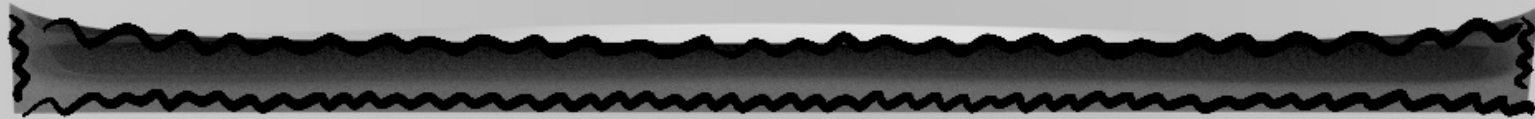

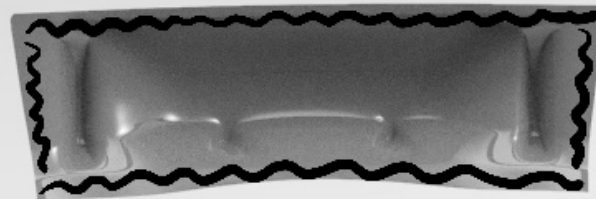
